

# THE LEGEND OF FISHER'S GHOST

Late one night in October 1826, a farmer named John Farley ran into the local hotel, 'The Harrow', in a state of shock claiming he had seen the ghost of Fred Fisher. This began the legend of Australia's most famous ghost.

# THE FESTIVAL OF FISHER'S GHOST IS BORN

The Campbelltown City Festival of Fisher's Ghost is one of the longest running community events in Australia.

Originally conceived in 1956 as an annual celebration to raise funds for new facilities and services, the festival went through several names.

During that same period, the legend of Fisher's Ghost experienced an unexpected rise in popularity, fuelled by Sydney radio stations and crowds gathered at Fisher's Ghost Creek hoping to spot the famous ghost.

Campbelltown Councillor, Greg Percival suggested combining the festival and the legend and in 1960, the Festival of Fisher's Ghost was born.
